



The Weapons of our Warfare

The MOST important weapons we have are the Blood of the Lamb and our testimony. The other Weapons of our Warfare are:

1. Belt of Truth
2. Breastplate of:
 - Righteousness
 - Faith
 - Love
3. Feet shod in preparation of gospel of peace
4. Shield of :
 - Faith
 - Salvation
 - Help (God is our help)
 - Favor
 - God our shield our glory
 - Truth
5. Helmet of salvation (knowing that we are saved, having our minds sealed)
6. Sword of the Spirit (Word of God, written and prophecy)
It is a sword of Excellency and two edged.
7. Bow of Bronze (Copper / Brass)
8. His gentleness has made us great (His peace brings power)
9. The yoke of Christ , being meek and lowly -> gentle and humble of spirit
10. Mantle (garment) of:
 - Zeal (Passion)
 - Praise
 - Humility
 - Vengeance (God is our vengeance)
 - Righteousness (Right standing – upright)
 - Judgment
 - Salvation (Rescued)
 - Armor of the Light
 - Christ likeness (put on Christ)
 - Holiness and Righteousness of the new man.
 - Mercy (Compassion)
 - Kindness
 - Humbleness of mind
 - Meekness (also humbleness but of nature)
 - Long-suffering (patience)
 - Forbearing one another (tolerance)
 - Forgiving yourselves (self forgiveness)

12. Horn of salvation
13. Arrows like lightning strikes the mark

Ephesians 6:12-18 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the world's rulers, of the darkness of this age,

against spiritual wickedness in high places. Therefore take to yourselves the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Therefore stand, having your **loins girded about with truth**¹, and having on the **breastplate of righteousness**² and your **feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace**³. Above all, take **the shield of faith**⁴, with which you shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the **helmet of salvation**⁵, and the **sword of the Spirit**⁶, which is the Word of God, praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching to this very thing with all perseverance and supplication for all saints.

2Samuel 22:35-36 He teaches my hands to war, so that my hands may bend a **bow of bronze**⁷. You have also given me the **shield of Your salvation**⁴, and **Your gentleness has made me great**⁸.

Psalms 18:34-35 He teaches my hands to war, so that a **bow of bronze**⁷ is bent by my arms. You have also given me the **shield of Your salvation**⁴; and **Your right hand has held me up, and Your gentleness has made me great**⁸.

Isaiah 59:17 For He put on **righteousness like a breastplate**², and a **helmet of salvation**⁵ on His head. And He put on the **garments of vengeance**¹⁰ for clothing, and was covered **with zeal like a cloak**¹⁰. (part of Full Armor in the OLD testament already !!!!)

Isaiah 61:3 to appoint to those who mourn in Zion, to give to them beauty for ashes, the **oil of joy**¹¹ for mourning, the **mantle of praise for the spirit of heaviness**¹⁰; so that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of Jehovah, that He might be glorified.

Deuteronomy 33:29 Blessed are you, O Israel! Who is like you, O people saved by Jehovah, the **shield of your help**⁴, and who is **the sword of your excellency**⁶! And your enemies shall be found liars to you, and you shall tread on their high places.

2Samuel 22:3 The God who is my Rock, in Him will I trust. He is my Shield, and the **Horn of my salvation**¹², my High Tower, and my Refuge, my Savior. You save me from violence.

Psalms 3:3 But **You, O Jehovah, are a shield for me; my glory**⁴, the One who lifts up my head.

Psalms 5:12 For You; O Jehovah, will bless the righteous; **with favor You will surround him as with a shield**⁴.

Psalms 91:4 He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall trust. **His truth shall be your shield**⁴, and buckler.

Job 20:24 He shall flee from the iron weapon, a **bow of bronze**⁷ shall pierce him.

Psalm 7:12-13 If he does not turn, He will whet His sword; He has bent His bow and made it ready. Yea, He has fitted him for instruments of death; He has made His arrows hotly pursue.

Zechariah 9:14 And Jehovah shall be seen over them, and His **arrow shall go forth like the lightning**¹³; and the Lord Jehovah shall blow the ram's horn, and shall go out with the windstorms of the south.

Job 36:32 **He covers His hands with the lightning, and commands it to strike the mark**¹³;

Hebrews 4:12 For the Word of God is living and powerful and sharper than **any two-edged sword**⁶, piercing even to the dividing apart of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Hebrews 4:12 God means what he says. What he says goes. His powerful Word is sharp as a surgeon's scalpel, cutting through everything, whether doubt or defense, laying us open to listen and obey.

1Peter 5:5 Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves to the elder. Yes, all of you be subject one to another, and be **clothed with humility**¹⁰: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

Job 29:14 I **put on righteousness, and it clothed me**¹⁰: **my judgment was as a robe**¹⁰ and a diadem.

Isaiah 61:10 I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the **garments of salvation**¹⁰, he hath covered me with the **robe of righteousness**¹⁰, as a bridegroom decketh himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth herself with her jewels.

Romans 13:12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us **put on the armor of light**¹⁰.

Galatians 3:27 Your baptism in Christ was not just washing you up for a fresh start. It also involved **dressing you in an adult faith wardrobe--Christ's life**¹⁰, the fulfillment of God's original promise.

Gal 3:27 For as many as were baptized into Christ, **you put on Christ**¹⁰.

Ephesians 4:22-24 For you ought to put off the old man (according to your way of living before) who is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind. And you should **put on the new man, who according to God was created in righteousness and true holiness**¹⁰.

Colossians 3:12-14 Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, **put on tender feelings of mercy, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, long-suffering, forbearing one another and forgiving yourselves**¹⁰, if anyone has a complaint against any. As Christ forgave you, so also you do. And above all these things **put on love**¹⁰, which is the bond of perfectness.

1Thessalonians 5:8 But let us, who are of the day, be calm, having put on the **breastplate of faith and love²** and the **hope of salvation for a helmet⁵**.

Matthew 11:29-30 Take **My yoke⁹** on you and learn of Me, for I **am meek and lowly in heart⁹**, and you shall find rest to your souls. For **My yoke is easy, and My burden is light⁹**.
